The Assistant Chief Counsel for the Legislation, Regulations, and General Law Division is responsible for all legislation, regulations, appropriations, and general law matters concerning the \$40 billion Federal-aid highway program and the \$1 billion Federal Lands Highway program. As the Assistant Chief Counsel, the incumbent will provide executive level legal advice and services directly to FHWA leadership and officials in the Office of the Secretary for Transportation. He/she will also provide personal counsel to FHWA and OST executive leadership in preparation for testimony before congressional committees, and coordinate and review all legislative and regulatory communications between FHWA and congressional staff, other Federal agencies, and the White House. In addition, the Assistant Chief Counsel will lead a professional staff of attorneys in the preparation of draft surface transportation reauthorization acts, appropriation bills, and subsequent implementing regulations and guidance, as well as in providing legal advice on a wide range of general and administrative law matters conducted within FHWA.
