

Founded in 1800, Middlebury has evolved dramatically from an institution established to train young men from Vermont and neighboring states for the ministry and other learned professions into the global institution it is today.

Middlebury's operating budget is approximately \$300 million for fiscal year 2015, with an endowment of just over \$1 billion. The College educates 2,450 undergraduate students in the tradition of the liberal arts on its 350-acre campus in Middlebury, Vermont. The Vermont campus is home to 270 full-time faculty members and 1,400 staff members.

Middlebury's reach extends beyond the undergraduate experience. The Middlebury Language Schools are known around the world for the excellence of their immersive approach to language learning. Starting in 1915, with the establishment of the first of the Middlebury Language Schools, to the opening of the Bread Loaf School of English in 1920, to the acquisition of the Middlebury Institute of International Studies at Monterey in 2010, Middlebury has always strived to do – and be – more, while always maintaining its deep commitment to academic excellence, creativity, and scholarship.
