The Consumer Protection Financial Bureau (CFPB) is seeking an Attorney-Advisor (General) to join its Office of Supervision Policy (OSP). The CFPB is a federal agency that helps consumer finance markets work by making rules more effective, by consistently and fairly enforcing those rules, and by empowering consumers to take more control over their economic lives.

The Office of Supervision is responsible for developing supervision strategies across bank and nonbank markets, ensuring consistency in policy decisions in supervisory markets, and providing ongoing support to examiners in each product market.

The responsibilities of a CFPB Attorney-Advisor include 1) Analyzing law and policy issues applicable to large banks and non-bank financial institutions under the CFPB's supervisory authority. 2) Recommending legal tools available to address legal, regulatory, supervisory and enforcement issues. 3) Determining and recommending legal or regulatory solutions designed to comply with CFPB strategies, policies and goals.

A Staff Attorney applicant must have at least two years of related experience.

The salary for this position ranges from \$90,270.00 - \$158,276.00.
