Essential Job Functions

Key responsibilities will include providing legal counsel on matters including business and corporate transactions, employment law and labor relations, contracts and grants, liability and insurance matters, real estate transactions, laws pertaining to students, regulatory compliance, intellectual property, and general academic matters.

All lawyers in the Office of the University Counsel are expected to work collaboratively within the University community. They must manage a wide variety of complicated issues in a fast-paced higher education environment, exercise independent judgment and function effectively with internal and external audiences.

Juris Doctorate degree from an ABA-accredited law school plus six years relevant legal practice experience in a high-quality and professional environment or an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above.

A member in good standing with the Washington State Bar, or have the ability to be admitted within twelve months of hire.

Superior written and oral communication and interpersonal skills.

Strong analytical and legal research skills.

Excellent academic and professional credentials.

Ability to translate complex problems into practical solutions.

High ethical standards and mature judgment. Strong aptitude for handling a variety of complex legal matters working independently and within a team environment.

Ability to function effectively in a fast-paced environment with multiple and changing priorities and objectives.

All candidates must show a demonstrated commitment to diversity and the university's mission, vision, and values.

Preferred Qualifications

The ideal candidate will possess one or more of the following:

- Prior in-house experience, particularly in higher education.
- Experience with litigation and/or dispute resolution.
