The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill invites nominations and applications for the position of Vice Chancellor and General Counsel. The General Counsel reports to the Chancellor and is a senior level administrator.

The University is a global higher education leader known for innovative teaching, research, and public service. A member of the prestigious Association of American Universities, Carolina regularly ranks as the best value for academic quality in U.S. public higher education and ranks 8th nationally for its dollar volume of sponsored research (\$990 million). Now in its third century, the University offers 77 bachelor's, 113 master's, 68 doctorate, and seven professional degree programs through 14 schools and the College of Arts and Sciences, including recognized schools of business, dentistry, education, government, information and library science, journalism and mass communication, medicine, nursing, pharmacy, public health, and social work. Every day, faculty – including two Nobel laureates – staff and students shape their teaching, research, and public service to meet North Carolina's most pressing needs in every region and all 100 counties.

The ideal candidate will be a collaborative leader who demonstrates an understanding of and has experience handling the types of issues faced by institutions of higher education. Successful applicants will have demonstrated excellent communication skills, the capacity for administrative and intellectual leadership, and proven record of ability to undertake complex legal issues and capacity to serve as a creative thinker and problem solver able to negotiate creative solutions to complex issues. A J.D. degree is required. The General Counsel serves at the pleasure of the Chancellor.
