

ASSISTANT FEDERAL DEFENDER

The Office of the Federal Defender for the Eastern District of Missouri has an opening for an **Assistant Federal Defender**. The office operates under authority of the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, to provide services of the highest quality to indigent persons in federal criminal cases. The main office is located in Saint Louis, Missouri with a branch office in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

The primary duty station is located in the St. Louis, Missouri office. Applicant must have the ability to immediately undertake the defense of major criminal cases in the United States District Court, as well as in the Court of Appeals for the Eighth Circuit. Applicant must be a graduate of an accredited law school and an active member in good standing of the bar in any state, territory or possession. Applicant must have excellent writing, legal research and advocacy skills. A reputation for integrity and a commitment to the representation of those unable to afford counsel are required qualities. Fluent Spanish is a plus. An Assistant Federal Defender may not engage in the private practice of law.

This is a full-time position with federal salary and benefits based on qualifications and experience. Salary is on a scale equivalent to that of Assistant United States Attorneys. This position is subject to mandatory electronic transfer (direct deposit) participation for payment of net pay. Current and future positions may be filled from this vacancy announcement. This position is subject to funding and background check.
